Notification of the Terms of the CAF Appeal Board Decision

Subject: Appeal against the CAF Disciplinary Board decision in Case DC23316 concerning the protest lodged following Match No. 52 – TotalEnergies CAF Africa Cup of Nations (AFCON) Morocco 2025 (Senegal v Morocco)

I. DECISION

- 1. The appeal lodged by the Fédération Royale Marocaine de Football (FRMF) is declared admissible in form.**
- 2. The appeal is upheld.**
- 3. The CAF Disciplinary Board decision in Case DC23316 is set aside.**
- 4. The CAF Appeal Board finds that the appellant's right to a fair hearing was not respected in the proceedings before the CAF Disciplinary Board.**
- 5. The CAF Appeal Board further finds that the conduct of the Senegal team falls within the scope of Articles 82 and 84 of the Regulations of the Africa Cup of Nations.**



6. The protest lodged by the Fédération Royale Marocaine de Football (FRMF) is upheld.
7. It is declared that the Fédération Sénégalaise de Football (FSF), through the conduct of its team, infringed Article 82 of the Regulations of the Africa Cup of Nations.
8. In application of Article 84 of the Regulations of the Africa Cup of Nations, the Senegal team is declared to have forfeited the match, with the result recorded as 3–0 in favour of the Fédération Royale Marocaine de Football (FRMF).
9. All other motions or prayers for relief are dismissed.
