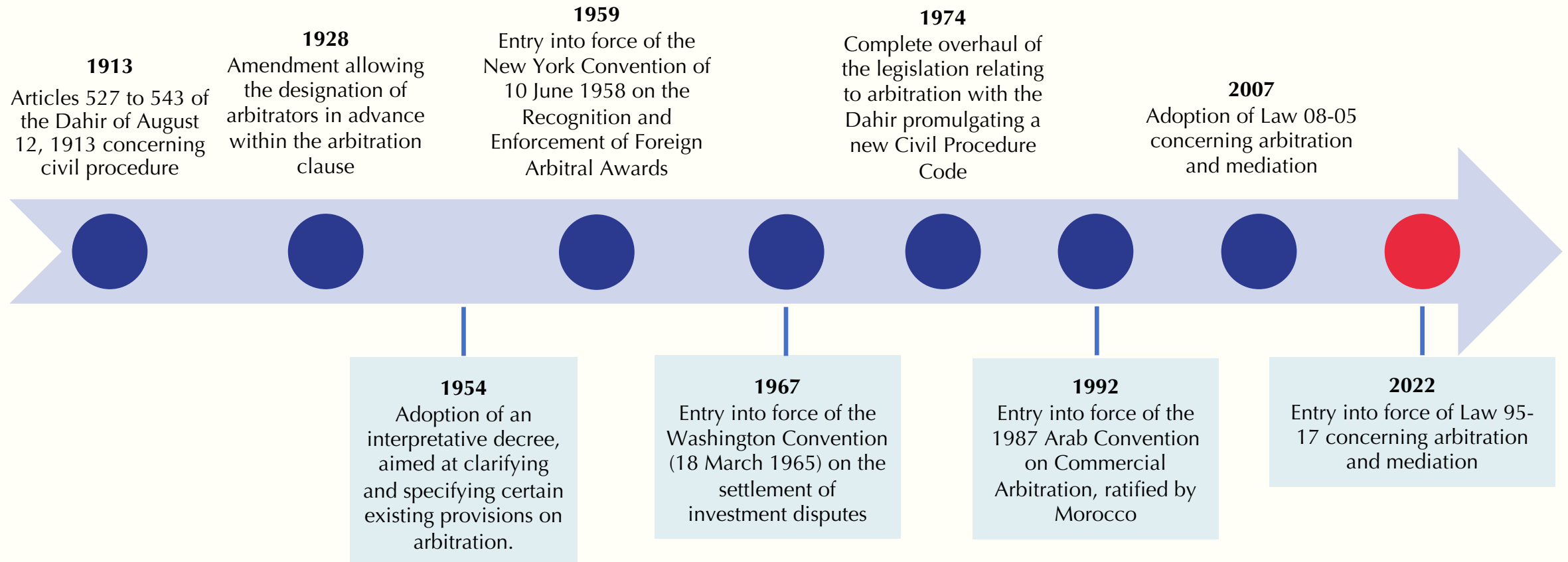

Grand Hassan II Stadium alone (115,000 seats)

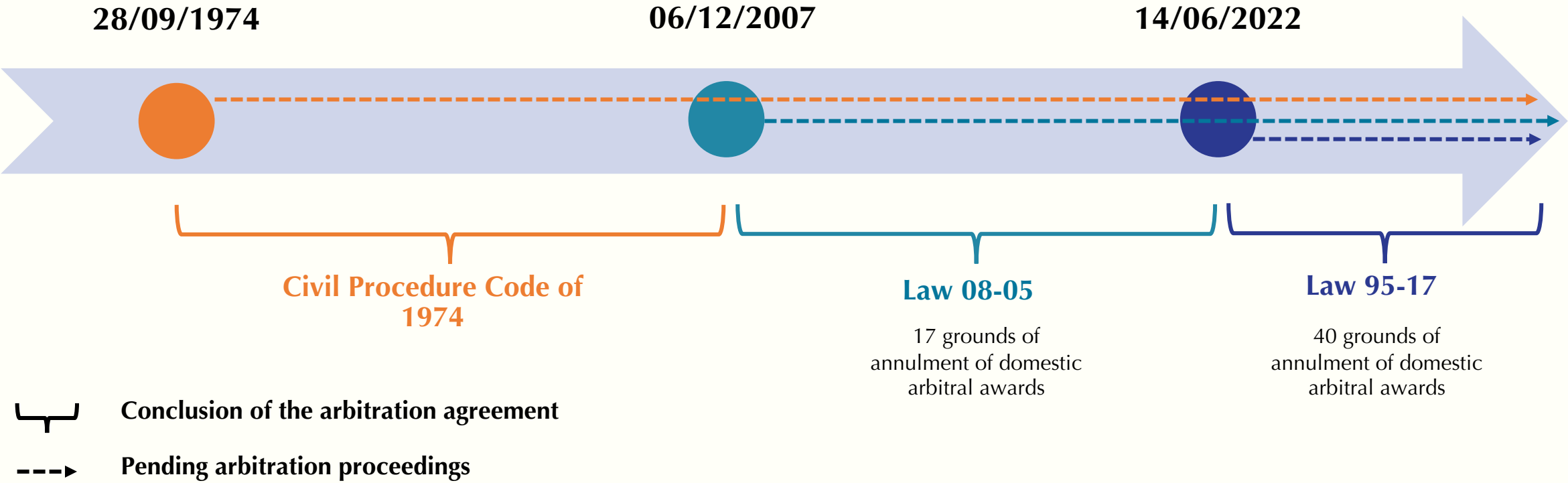

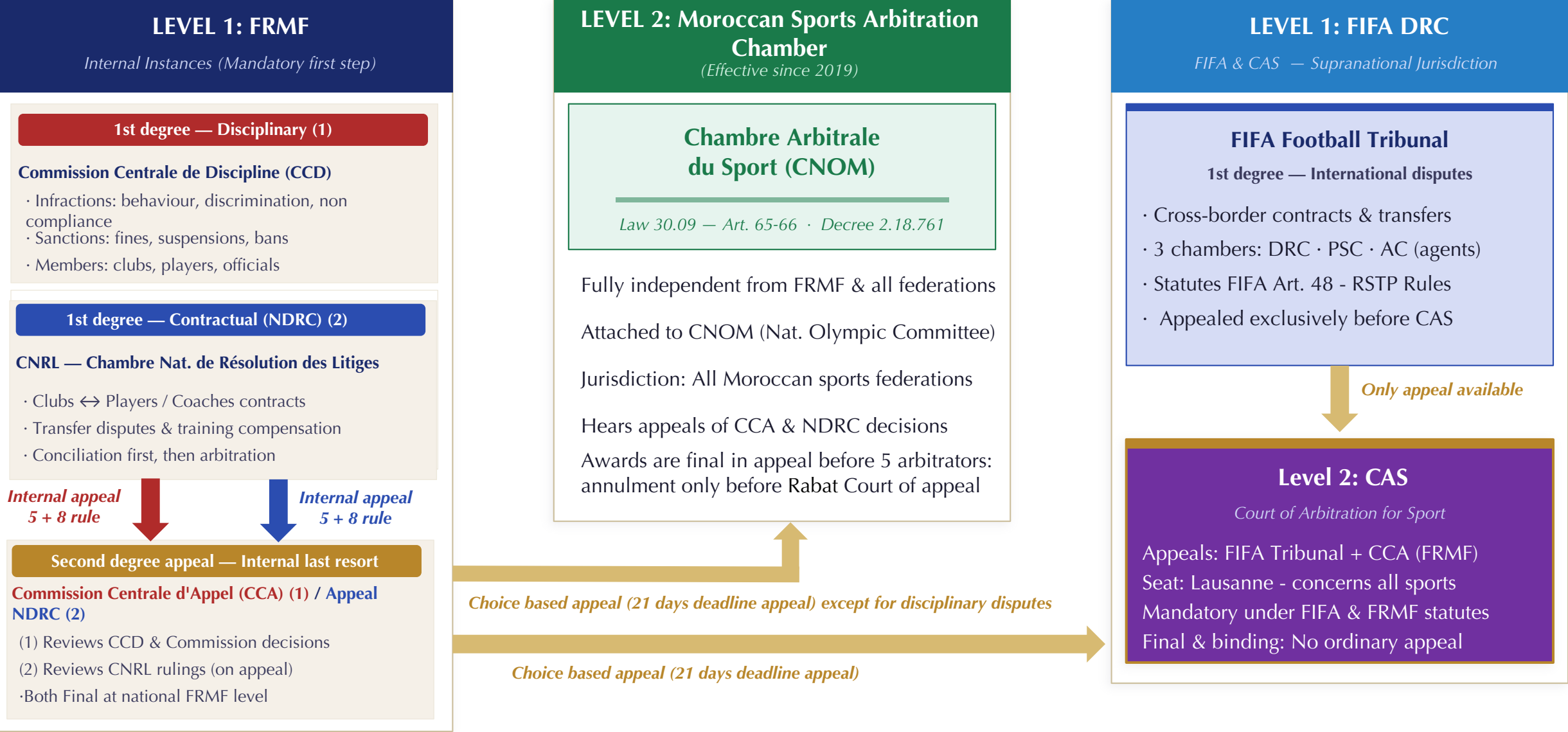

Morocco & International Football — Dispute Resolution Roadmap



SPORTS ARBITRATION CHAMBER (effective since 2019, 181 cases heard until 2024)

Jurisdictional competence - Law No. 30-09 · Implementing decree (Art. 38-39)

Parties that may refer a matter to SAC - Art. 44 Law 30-09

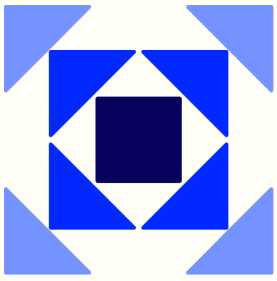

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Condition for referral to arbitration: an arbitration clause inserted in the articles of association / contracts **OR** a submission agreement concluded by the parties after the dispute has arisen.

SAC JURISDICTION	EXCLUSIONS
FIRST INSTANCE (3 arbitrators) Art. 38 §1 — Implementing decree - Disputes arising from the organization of physical and sports activities - Disputes arising from the practice of physical and sports activities - Between all parties referred to in Article 44 of Law No. 30-09 APPEAL (5 arbitrators) Art. 38 §2 — Implementing decree - Decisions rendered at first instance by CAS-Maroc itself - Decisions on the granting / withdrawal of high-level athlete status - Decisions of a federation, association or sports body if the bylaws so provide	 Disciplinary sanctions imposed by federations SAC does not have jurisdiction over appeals against disciplinary sanctions imposed by sports federations on their members. Art. 39 Décret · Art. 24 §1 Loi 30-09  Doping-related disputes Any dispute relating to doping matters. Art. 44 Law 30-09 — Express exclusion  Unavailable rights of the parties Disputes relating to rights over which the parties do not have free disposal cannot be submitted to arbitration. KEY TAKE-AWAY

The Sports Arbitration Chamber is a national arbitral body with two levels of jurisdiction: it rules at first instance on contractual sports disputes between qualified parties (Art. 44 of Law No. 30-09), and hears appeals against decisions of federations or the CNSH. Its scope is delimited by three mandatory exclusions — federation discipline, doping, and non-disposable rights – which fall under other legal avenues.
